Poutama's Trip to Kitchener Park

On Tuesday, 5th of November, Poutama jumped on the bus and were lucky enough to have a fun trip to Kitchener Park to learn about our local history, the forest and it's native flora and fauna.

Poutama learnt local stories from Matua Anaru. We learnt that the first ever Poi was made out of clay and made a whistle sound when you spun it. Matua Anaru also taught us how to whistle with a leaf. We all got split into groups and did three rotations. The bug activity was really fun but gross for some people. We had to find bugs and try to catch them in a little container with a spoon. Poutama also learnt about different birds and some fun facts about them. One is that a Tui has two voice boxes and a cut in their tongue to allow two different sounds. The last activity was learning about trees and plants. We talked about the many different trees, the levels of the forest and also that a type of plant can heal wounds. For all three rotations, it was explained why the trees, bugs and birds are so essential for the life of the Forest.

It was a wonderful experience and right in our own back yard!
