#### Strike Action

Kia ora whānau

We have been officially notified by NZEI Te Riu Roa (the union for Principals, Teachers, and Support Staff) of a proposed **full-day strike on Thursday, October 23, 2025.** 

The action stems from a failure to agree on terms that ensure appropriate resourcing for tamariki and competitive remuneration to retain and attract quality professional staff.

#### **Limited Supervision Available**

While the majority of our staff are NZEI members and will be striking, we will have a small number of non-union staff available to supervise students who cannot be cared for at home. Students who attend school will follow a modified programme for the day.
